Entries will remain open in all races until one hour prior to post time.

All riders must sign Waiver of Liability forms and must provide proof of insurance before being allowed to ride.

All people who plan to be on horseback must sign waiver of Liability forms and must wear protective headgear. All race riders must wear protective vests.

All horses must be checked in with Pippy McCormick at the paddock one hour prior to their post time listed on this overnite, or they will be scratched.

The use of raised toes (toe grabs) is prohibited. Horses will be

scratched or disqualified.

Please check the information on this overnite. Any changes or corrections can be made prior to scratch time to make the program.

Entries must be paid before saddle cloths will be issued.

As required by the Virginia Department of Agriculture: "All horses must be accompanied by a report of an official negative test for equine infectious anemia (Coggins Test) conducted within the last 12 months. The Certificate must accompany all horses in order to gain access to the grounds. This requirement will be strictly enforced. A health certificate must accompany horses shipping from outside Virginia.

There will be an extra flat race at the Blue Ridge Point to Point on May 2 - 8th Jumper's Flat Race - 1 1/2 miles. For Four-Year-Olds and Up which have started over fences. Four-year-olds, 155 lbs.; older, 160 lbs. Maidens allowed 10 lbs. Winners under rules on the flat in 2009-10, 10 lbs. extra.
