Placing of race will be determined by placing judges based on which pony's nose crosses the line first.

Entry Fee \$25 per entry. All entries must be acceptable to the Committee

All riders must have a guardian sign a release with Anna Coyne on race day before receiving a saddle towel.

RACE CONDITIONS:

Races are open to riders who have not had their 7th birthday as of January 1st on well-behaved ponies at least 5 years of age. All ponies must have a lead line attached to their bridle and must be accompanied by an adult. About 50 yds. Ponies may trot or walk. Ponies breaking to a canter must go behind the last entry in the field before continuing or may be Disqualified. Riders must wear ASTM approved helmets; overgirths and protective vests are highly encouraged. Racing silks encouraged, riding attire accepted. If entries warrant, the race may be split into two divisions.

Riders that are not able to post or ride on their own yet may have an assistant.
