Radnor Hunt Races Pony Races

Entries open Wednesday May 8 at Central Entry Office. Entries CLOSE on Monday May 13 at noon. www.CentralEntryOffice.com

<u>Lead line races</u> are open to riders on well-behaved ponies at least 5 years of age and not over 14.2 hands. The race will be in the stretch to the wire. Ponies may trot or walk. Ponies breaking to a canter must pull up and resume trotting. No whips, blinkers, or spurs. Riders that are not able to post or ride on their own may have an assistant on the far side of pony for Division 1.

Placing of entry will be determined by placing judges on which ponies nose crosses the line first. NO Cantering. Leaders must be an adult. Entries exhibiting any unsportsmanlike-like conduct will be excused. Entries not making sufficient attempts to resume trotting after breaking into a canter may be placed behind more controlled entries if deemed fair by the judges.

Riders competing in leadline may not also compete in small or large pony flat races.

<u>Junior races</u> open to juniors who have not reached their 16th birthday as of the first of the current year. Mounts to be a minimum of five years old. Catch weights. Small ponies will be defined as under 13hh. Large ponies will be defined as 13hh to 14.2 hh. Horses are over 14.2 hh. Riders and horses / ponies must be deemed acceptable to the committee.

Entries for all leadline and Junior races are required to wear approved helmets. Neck straps, safety stirrups, and safety vests are encouraged.

Ribbons for first, second and third as well as best turned out. THE MAIN GOAL IS FOR EVERYONE TO LEARN ABOUT PONY RACING AND HAVE FUN!

Lead Line Trot Division 1: For riders four years old and younger on ponies that are at least five years old. Walk and trot only. Approximately 30 yards.

Lead Line Trot Division 2: For riders from five to 8 years old on ponies that are at least five years old. Walk and trot only. Approximately 30 yards.

Junior Flat Race - Small Pony: For small ponies (up to 13hh), ridden by jockeys who have not reached their 16th birthday as of the 1st of the year. Approximately 1 to 2 furlongs, exact distance to be determined on the day according to assessment of entries.

Junior Flat Race - Large Pony: For large ponies (13hh - 14.2hh), ridden by jockeys who have not reached their 16th birthday as of the 1st of the year. Approximately 2 - 4 furlongs, exact distance to be determined on the day according to assessment of entries.

Junior Flat Race - Horse: For horses (over 14.2hh), ridden by jockeys who have not reached their 16th birthday as of the 1st of the year. Approximately 2 - 4 furlongs, exact distance to be determined on the day according to assessment of entries.
